ODOT permission letter (for work in ODOT rights-of-way)

Site plan showing:

- Proposed facility locations including manholes, poles, etc.
- Size, type, and depth of conduit/pipeline
- Relation to existing infrastructure (roads, driveways, sidewalks, utilities, etc.)
- Locations of borings, excavations, and pavement cuts

Updated list of emergency service providers including contact names and information

REMINDER: ALL UTILITY LINE LOCATES AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERMIT HOLDER. CITY CAN REQUIRE LOCATES TO BE POTHoled.

PERMITS ARE ONLY VALID FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE.

PERMITS SHALL NOT BE AUTOMATICALLY EXTENDED FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING WEATHER.

Certification

I certify that the information provided in this application is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge. I understand that failure to comply with City, State, and/or Federal regulations or provide updated information may result in revocation of the permit.

I acknowledge all restoration work required of any roadway, sidewalk, or other pavement, including sod replacement if applicable, by any permit holder shall be performed without delay by the permittee unless otherwise agreed to by the city in writing. Upon completion of the work and the subsequent removal of the obstruction, the permittee shall notify the Development Services Department that the obstruction has been removed and is ready for final inspection.
