§312-20 – The lot size, width, depth, shape, orientation, and minimum building setback lines shall be appropriate for the location of the subdivision and the type of development.

§361-12 – An improved lot shall not hereafter be divided into two or more lots unless all lots resulting from such division comply with all the applicable yard, space, area, parking and loading regulations of the zoning district in which located. Lot dimensions and building lines shall conform to the existing zoning regulations. Each lot shall have access and front upon a public street. Double frontage lots should be avoided except where their use will produce definite advantages in meeting special situations in relation to topography and proper land use. Side lot lines shall be substantially at right angles or radial to street lines.
